

# Student Bursary Policy

Wasausink Lands Inc., Student Bursary is to assist Wasauksing First Nation registered Members in post-secondary education. The Bursary is intended to foster and advance the interest of the Ojibway's of Wasauksing (Parry Island #16) First Nation Members.

1. Two bursaries per year will be awarded to the successful WFN members in the amount of \$750.00. (1,500.00 per year)
2. All Applications will be reviewed by WLI Board of Directors.
3. Successful candidates will be notified by the 30<sup>th</sup> of June and the 30<sup>th</sup> of December.
4. Payment will be made via cheque to the successful candidate.
5. The bursaries are unconditional. No receipts will be required.
6. Application needs to include proof of enrollment in an accredited College or University Program.
7. You must be in good standings with WLI to be eligible to participate in program.
8. Successful candidates can only win one Bursary in this program.

Please note: WLI Board of Directors are authorized to make changes to this program if and when issues occur. The Board of Directors will review policy annually.
